What has already been done?

IO1: In-Service Training Programme and Handbook

Based on the feedback of the Research Control Groups, the proposed Manual was updated. The Training Programme and Manual will consist of the following modules:

- **Module 1:** Innovation in Learning
- **Module 2:** New Didactic Methods for Adult Learning
- **Module 3:** Collaborating through Digital Technologies – Introducing the OutsideIn Toolbox
- **Module 4:** Introduction to Instructional Design for e-learning
- **Module 5:** E-moderation for online learning - netiquette, copyright and online safety

IO2: Digital Toolbox – Mini Learning Format Resources (MLFRs)

The project partners created 10 common resources for the following subjects:

- ✓ Mother tongue
- ✓ Cultural awareness
- ✓ Entrepreneurship
- ✓ Foreign language
- ✓ Learning to learn
- ✓ Mathematics, science and technology
- ✓ Social & Civic

IO1: In-Service Training Programme and Handbook
